

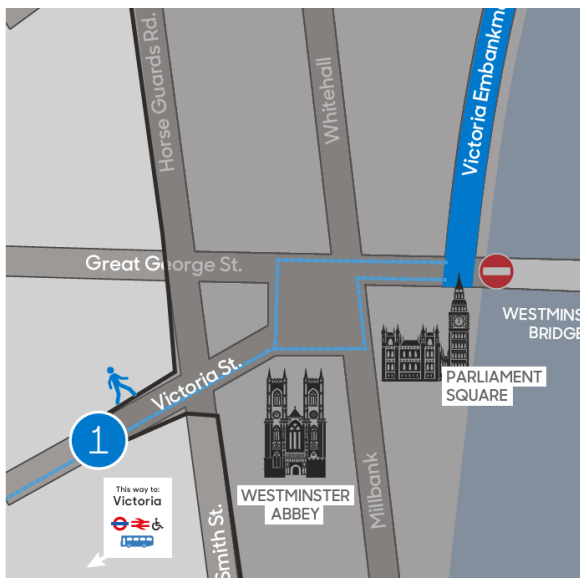
BLUE 1 ENTRANCE

Getting to Your Entrance

Your entrance will **open at 8:00pm** and **close at 10:30pm**. Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time before your entrance closes. To access the **Blue 1** entrance, you must arrive via **Victoria Station** as other routes will be restricted or closed and this may lead to a delay in your arrival.

Road and footpath closures will be in place across central London from 2pm on the 31 of December. You should plan to use the Underground and National Rail services to reach Victoria Station and the Blue 1 entrance. Start planning your journey using the [TfL](#) and [National Rail](#) websites.

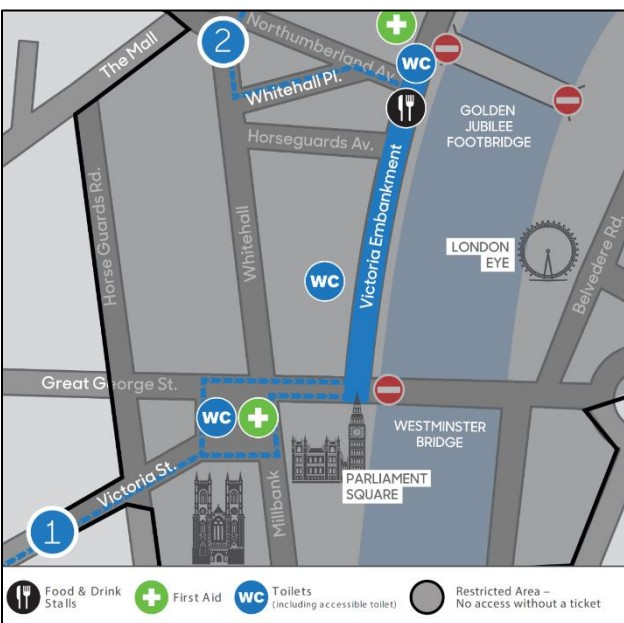
Mainline: Southeastern, Southern or Gatwick Express

Underground: District, Circle or Victoria Lines

Walking directions: Exit Victoria Station or get off your bus, make your way onto Victoria Street and follow the walking route signposted to the right. Continue walking towards the River Thames and Westminster Abbey, until you reach the stewarded Blue 1 entrance.

This is around a 10-minute walk and be sure to observe instructions from our stewards and signage from the station exit.
